

THE WATCHERS / CHARACTER MAP

Who does what?

Separate the rebels, those harmed on earth, and the messengers sent in response.



Semjaza

Leads the shared decision and fears bearing its penalty alone.

6:3–8



Azazel

Teaches weapons, metalworking and adornment; his teaching is accused.

8:1; 9:6



Watchers + human women → giant offspring → widening violence

This line condenses the narrative in 7:1–6. It is not a complete genealogy or a ranking of heavenly beings.

FOUR MESSENGERS. FOUR ASSIGNMENTS.

Uriel

Warns Noah of the coming flood.

10:1–3

Raphael

Binds Azazel; receives the command to heal the earth.

10:4–8

Gabriel

Sends the offspring into conflict with one another.

10:9–10

Michael

Binds Semjaza and his associates.

10:11–15

Text anchors: 1 Enoch 6–10. Names are simplified for navigation; Charles's spellings vary.

THE WATCHERS / STORY SEQUENCE

From descent to restoration

Six movements through chapters 6–11. Follow the changes in scale, from a shared choice to a world in need of healing.



Sequence diagram of 1 Enoch 6–11. Restoration is the passage's promised horizon, not a modern prediction.
